INTRODUCTION

This document was designed to provide systems analysts and programmers with technical information sufficient for the parsing and loading of ProQuest Dissertations & Theses database records in USMARC format. All the data we distribute is highly structured and systematically produced. This document will help you to understand Dissertation Abstracts data and its structure in greater detail, enabling you to more effectively manage the processing of our information on your system.

Subsequent chapters will provide:

- Descriptions of the data format
- A sample record as it might appear on your system
- A sample record as distributed by ProQuest
- Listings of all fields that can be present in records
- Details of the individual fields that can be present in records

Additional material can be found in the Appendixes. Some of this material can be used to build system lookup tables.

File Delivery Method

ProQuest delivers data from their electronic vault by FTP, or on magnetic or optical storage media.

File Types

ProQuest Dissertations & Theses provides the following kinds of files:

- MARCDATA.MRC—a file containing USMARC records, corresponding to the dissertations contained in the other discs or files (if any)
- *.CSV file—an index file that identifies--for each USMARC record--the disc(s) on which the corresponding PDF and any other digital material can be found. Entries in an index file are in Comma-Separated Value format, with a publication number as the first element, followed by one or more disc identifiers
- *.PDF files—complete dissertations, in Portable Document Format
- supplementary digital materials—additional files provided by a dissertation's author; various formats are possible (audio, video, spreadsheets, etc.)

MARCDATA.MRC Record Format

ProQuest creates database records in the following format:

- USMARC (U.S. standard format for MACHine Readable Cataloging)—This format allows the capture and transmission of citation and abstracting and indexing information. This structured data is arranged in fields and its content is labeled with a specific set of tags and subfield codes.

Character Repertoire and Encoding

ProQuest's USMARC files--in their uncompressed state--consist of 8-bit bytes that primarily represent characters from the US-ASCII character set. Other 8-bit bytes serve as delimiters, terminators, or record separators in the USMARC files.

Record Processing

ProQuest Dissertations & Theses data is sent (whether compressed or uncompressed) as a single MARCDATA.MRC file. Your parsing program will make use of record length, record terminator, and (possibly) record separator information embedded in the file to identify each of the individual records it contains. Further details of this file format appear later in this document.

ProQuest Dissertations & Theses

A dissertation is an in-depth, original research manuscript written by a degree candidate in fulfillment of the requirements for an advanced degree--either a doctoral or masters. Representing the research of nearly every North American university and many other institutions from around the world, ProQuest Dissertations & Theses is your single comprehensive source of dissertation and thesis information.

ProQuest Dissertations & Theses files can include content drawn from these ProQuest dissertation publications:

- CDI - Comprehensive Dissertation Index
- DAI - Dissertation Abstracts International
- MAI - Masters Abstracts International
- ADD -American Doctoral Dissertations

We have over 2.5 million citations in the database, and full text for 1.9 million of them in our vaults. Of those 1.9 million, almost 800,000 are available in PDF format. Over 1,000 graduate schools are represented in the database, with coverage from 1861 to the present. The database includes abstracts from July 1980 forward for dissertations, abstracts from 1988 forward for masters theses, with PDF availability from 1997 forward. All abstracts are written by the authors of the dissertations or theses.

With subjects ranging from the topical to the esoteric, ProQuest Dissertations & Theses is clearly multi-disciplinary. It includes coverage in literature, education, chemistry, engineering, psychology, business, economics, history, philosophy, sociology, and information science.

USMARC FORMAT

Records and Record Lengths

An individual record consists of all the data belonging to one bibliographic entity (a dissertation or thesis). The length of a record (expressed in numeric characters) is indicated by the 5-character Record Length, which is conveyed in the first 5 bytes of each record. A USMARC record has a maximum length of 99,999 bytes. Every record ends with a record terminator character (hex "1D").

As an option specified at the time of MARC file generation, a record terminator character can also be followed by a record separator--a linefeed character (hex "0A"). If appended to records, these hex "0A" record separators are not counted in calculations of record length. Most of our customers prefer to receive files that do not include such record separators.

Record Layout

The record format is based on the Library of Congress USMARC format, ISO Standard 2709. The record structure is an implementation of the American National Standard for *Bibliographic Information Interchange* (ANSI Z39.2).

Each record has four parts as shown below:

- 1.0 Fixed-length leader
- 2.0 Variable-length directory
- 3.0 Variable-length data fields
- 4.0 Record terminator

1.0 Leader

The leader contains 24 bytes (eight-bit characters), as represented below. There is one leader for each record (dissertation).

1.1 Record length

The record length in the leader is a five-digit decimal number equal to the number of bytes (or eight-bit characters) in the record, including the five characters in this number. Therefore, since only five places are used, the maximum length is 99,999 characters.

1.2 Status

A single character in position 5 indicates the status of the record. We use only “n” (new record).

1.3 Type of record/bibliographic level

A single character in position 6 indicates the type of record. A single character in position 7 indicates the bibliographic level of the data.

1.4 Not used

Characters 8 and 9 are not used in the UMI system.

1.5 Data field indicator count

This single-character data element in position 10 consists of one decimal digit equal to the number of indicators which appear as the first data element of each variable data field. The indicator count is 2 for all records.

1.6 Subfield code count

A subfield code consists of a delimiter (ASCII "1F"), represented in this document as a "\$", followed by a data element identifier. A single decimal digit in position 11 is equal to the length (in characters) of each subfield code used within a variable data field. The subfield code count is 2 for all records.

1.7 Base address of data

A data element in position 12-16 consists of five decimal digits and is equal to the combined length (in characters) of the leader and directory (Figure A, section 1.0 and 2.0).

1.8 Encoding level/descriptive cataloging form

A single character in position 17 indicates the encoding level, or fullness, of the record. A blank in position 18 indicates that the record is not formulated according to the Anglo-American Cataloguing Rules.

1.9 Not used

Character 19 is not used.

1.10 Entry map

This item defines the structure of a directory entry and consists of four characters in position 20-23.

Character 20 is a decimal digit indicating the size (in characters) of the "length of field" portion of each directory entry. The digit in position 20 will always be 4.

Character 21 is a decimal digit indicating the size (in characters) of the "starting character position" portion of each entry in the directory. The digit in position 21 will always be 5.

Characters 22 and 23 are not used. The digit in positions 22 and 23 will always be 0.

Directory

2.0 Directory

The directory is a variable-length field consisting of a variable number of fixed-length entries and a field terminator character. The directory contains one entry for each variable control and data field in the record.

2.1 Tag

The first field in a directory entry consists of a number that identifies the data field addressed by characters 7 through 11 of the directory entry. This field is three characters long.

2.2 Length of field

"Length of field" is the number of characters in the data field pointed to by this entry. Included in the length are the data field indicators, subfield code(s) and terminator. This field is four characters long.

2.3 Address of field

"Address of field" is the character position of the first character for the specified data field. This field is five characters long.

All field addresses are taken relative to the beginning of the data field section. The first position of the data field section is position 0. To obtain the offset into the record, where the first byte of the record is 0, add the address of the field to the base address of data. (*See* section 1.5 of the leader.)

NOTE: The end of the directory is marked with a field terminator (hex "1E").

Data Field Format

The record consists of a mixture of variable-length control fields and data fields. Each variable-length data field consists of two indicators, one or more subfield codes, the field data and a field terminator. A subfield code consists of a delimiter and a lower case letter or number. Control fields do not contain indicators or subfield codes, and have tags beginning with the digits “00”.

3.0 Data field indicators

Two indicators occupy the first character positions of a variable data field. Indicators provide additional information about the type of data in the variable data field. A blank is used in an undefined indicator position of a variable data field. Control fields do not contain indicators.

3.1 Subfield code

A subfield code identifies an individual element within a variable data field. There is at least one subfield code per variable data field. Each subfield code consists of a delimiter (hex "1F") and a lower case letter or number. The delimiter is represented by a dollar sign (\$) in this document. Control fields do not contain subfield codes.

3.2 Data field

Data fields are actual information for the record. The specific contents of each data field are described in detail in the USMARC Tag Descriptions section of this document.

3.3 Field terminator

The final character of each data field is a field terminator (hex "1E").

3.4 Record terminator

A record terminator (hex "1D") appears at the end of every record.

To test whether preschool children's verbal responses and attitudes would be different when interacting with an orthopedically handicapped compared to a physically normal adult, 81 preschool children were randomly assigned to one of two groups. One group interacted with the examiner for two play tasks, reading and nerf basketball, while she sat in a wheelchair. One group interacted with the examiner for the two play tasks while she sat in a chair. The children were able to identify a wheelchair by name and they were likely to report that a person seated in a wheelchair could not walk. There was no difference in the children's attitudes toward the examiner seated in a chair rather than a wheelchair. There was a distinct difference in verbal responses between the two groups. There was a tendency for the children to converse more with the examiner in a chair rather than a wheelchair, and they discussed the play task more when she was seated in a chair. There was also a significant difference in verbal responses for each play task. The children were more likely to converse with the examiner and to discuss the play task and other topics during nerf basketball than reading.

USMARC Tag Descriptions

001 Publication Number 001

Description

This field contains the dissertation's unique identifier, a 7-character "publication number" prefixed by a 3-letter prefix: "AAI". Thus, the length of this field will be 10 characters. For DAI parts A and B and MAI, values 01-07 in first two bytes of the 7-character publication number means the dissertation is not available for sale by ProQuest and should be so designated. For DAI Section C, all publication numbers begin with "C", and none are available for sale by ProQuest. Some DAI parts A and B records (British Dissertations) have publication numbers beginning with "D-" or "DX". Some DAI parts A and B and MAI records (Canadian theses) have publication numbers beginning with "M" or "N".

Format

The field ends with a field terminator.

005 Date and Time of Latest Transaction 005

Description

This field specifies the date and time of the latest record transaction and serves as a version identifier for the record.

Format

The date is recorded in 8 numeric characters in the pattern YYYYMMDD (4 for the year, 2 for the month, and 2 for the day). The time is recorded in 8 characters in the pattern HHMMSS.F (2 for the hour, 2 for the minute, 2 for the second, decimal point, and 1 for the tenth of a second). The 24-hour clock (00-23) is used. The field ends with a field terminator.

008 Fixed Length Data Elements 008

Description

This field provides coded information about the record as a whole and about bibliographic aspects of the item being described.

Format

Fixed-length, 40 characters. The field ends with a field terminator.

Description

This field contains the International Standard Book Number, which is included when available.

Format

Description

This field contains the Record control number from the 001 field, to allow a local system to replace the 001 Record control number field with its own local system control number, yet retain the PQDT control number.

Two blank indicators, subfield delimiter, data element identifier "a", ProQuest's MARC organization code enclosed in parentheses "(MiAaPQ)", and the record control number from the 001 field. The field ends with a field terminator.

This field contains the name of the first or only author of the dissertation. If there is more than one author of a dissertation, the second and any subsequent author names will appear in 700 Added Entry fields.

Format

First indicator "1", second indicator blank, delimiter, data element identifier "a", and the first author's name. The field ends with a period and a field terminator.

242**English Translation of Foreign Title****242****Description**

For DAI Section C records, if the main title is not in English, an English title will appear in this field. For DAI sections A and B, only the 245 Title field will appear.

Format

First indicator "0", second indicator "0", delimiter, data element identifier "a", the English translation of the title of the dissertation, subfield delimiter, data element identifier "y", and "eng" (for English language). The field ends with a field terminator.

This field contains the title of a dissertation or thesis, and will occur once per record. For DAI Section C if the main title is not in English, a translated title will appear in the 242 English Translation of Foreign Title field. For DAI sections A and B, only the dissertation title will appear.

Format

First indicator "1", second indicator "0", subfield delimiter, data element identifier "a", and the title of the dissertation. The field ends with a period (or other mark of punctuation) and a field terminator.

This field, when present, contains the number of pages in the dissertation. For DAI Parts A and B, there will be no 300 field for dissertations not available for sale by ProQuest. For DAI Section C, the absence of a 300 field means that the number of pages is unknown (many DAI Section C records represent titles which are not for sale by ProQuest).

Format

Two blank indicators, subfield delimiter, data element identifier "a", and the number of pages. The field ends with a period (or other mark of punctuation) and a field terminator.

Description

This field contains source information: database identification, volume number or source code, and sometimes includes page number(s) from the Dissertation Abstracts publication in which the citation first appeared. Volume/issue strings that include a trailing "(E)" indicate "electronic" volume numbers; these appear in cases where no corresponding physical Dissertation Abstracts volume was printed. Access to the database identification is provided in the 773 Host Item Entry field. DAI records include a Section designation (A, B, or C). DAI-C dissertations are not for sale by ProQuest Dissertations & Theses.

Format

Two blank indicators, subfield delimiter, data element identifier "a", and the source information. The field ends with a period and a field terminator. *Note: Publication page number is always 4 characters long and may have leading zeros.*

Description

This field contains the name of another publisher of the dissertation. It appears only in some DAI section C records.

Format

Two blank indicators, subfield delimiter, data element identifier "a", and the publisher information. The field ends with a period and a field terminator.

500**General Note (Advisor)****500****Description**

This field contains the name(s) of academic advisors or committee members, preceded by a designation of their function. Format is [function]: [name]; [name]; [name]. Designation of function is followed by ":", and multiple names are separated by ";". Names are in direct order, i.e. first name followed by last name. This field is optional, and may not occur more than once per record.

Format

Two blank indicators, subfield delimiter, data element identifier "a", and the advisor information. The field ends with a period and a field terminator.

500**General Note (other)****500****Description**

This field contains additional notes, other than those relating to source, publisher, or advisor. This kind of note may occur only once per record.

Format

Two blank indicators, subfield delimiter, data element identifier "a", and the content of the note. The field ends with a period and a field terminator.

502**Dissertation Note****502****Description**

This field contains information about the degree: the degree earned by the author, the name of the granting institution, and the year the degree was granted. The degree awarded may be lacking for DAI Section C and some Canadian records.

Format

Two blank indicators, subfield delimiter, data element identifier "a", and the degree information. The field ends with a period and a field terminator.

Two blank indicators, subfield delimiter, data element identifier "a", and the availability information. The field ends with a period and a field terminator.

Description

This field contains the author-prepared abstract summary of the dissertation. Each 520 field represents a paragraph of the abstract. On occasion--as in the last of the examples below--an additional note may appear, describing the dissertation as being a compound document.

Format

Two blank indicators, subfield delimiter, data element identifier "a", and the abstract. The field ends with a period (or other mark of punctuation) and a field terminator.

Description

This field contains the location of a reference copy. The field appears in some DAI Section C records only.

Format

First indicator "2", second indicator blank, subfield delimiter, data element identifier "a", and the location. The field ends with a period and a field terminator.

590**Local Note (School Code)****590****Description**

This field contains ProQuest's school code for the institution awarding the degree. This USMARC field is locally defined by ProQuest Dissertations & Theses. It allows a local system to provide the same level of access to USMARC-formatted PQDT records as is available in ProQuest's online databases. If access to School Codes is not desired, delete the 590 Local Note (School Code) and 790 School Code fields from the USMARC record before loading it into the local system.

Format

Two blank indicators, subfield delimiter, data element identifier "a", and the school code information. The field ends with a field terminator.

This field contains the subject term. This field is repeatable and will occur once for each subject term assigned to the dissertation.

Format

First indicator blank, second indicator "4", subfield delimiter, data element identifier "a", and the subject term. The field ends with a period and a field terminator.
