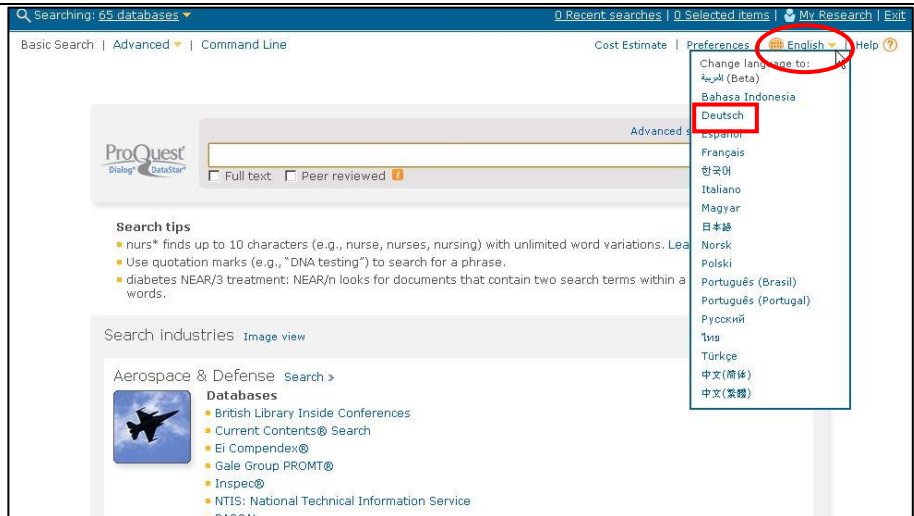


CUSTOMIZING USER PREFERENCES

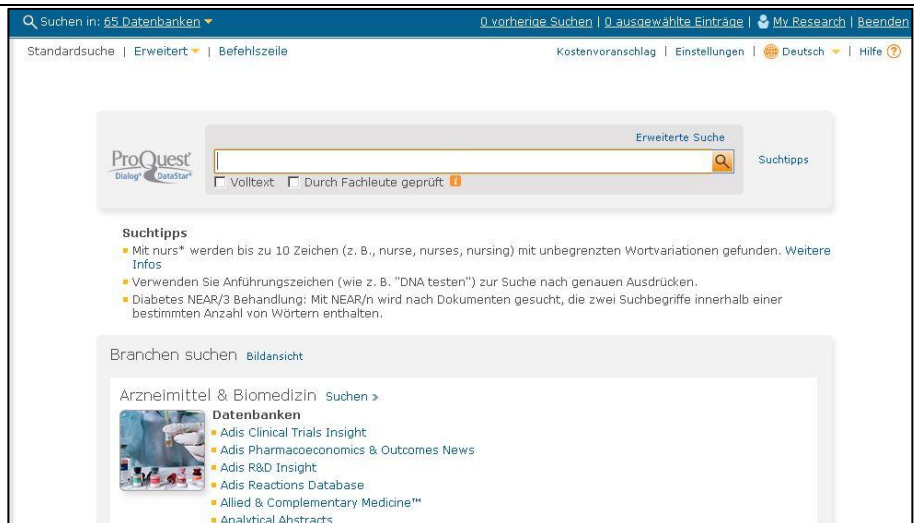
Customize the language of my interface

TASK: Need to change the language of the ProQuest Dialog™ interface? It's quite simple. You can just click the language link on the top right of the screen on any page to make a temporary change for this session only, or you can click **Preferences** to go into My Research and set a default language.

1. To change the interface language for the current session only, log in to ProQuest Dialog; then click the language icon on the top right. For example, in the drop list click **Deutsch**.

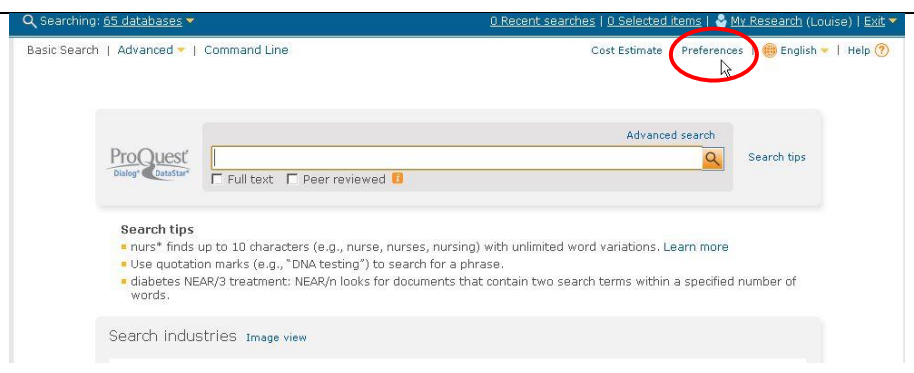


2. The interface language changes to German. After you log off, the language will return to English.

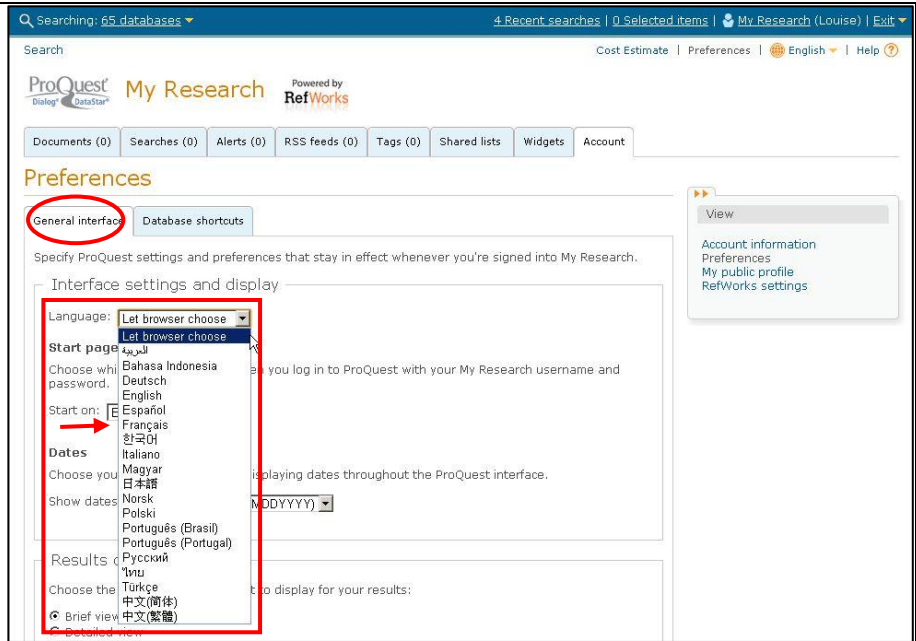


3. To set a default for the interface language click **Preferences**.

Note: You must have and log into your **My Research** account to make and save interface preferences.



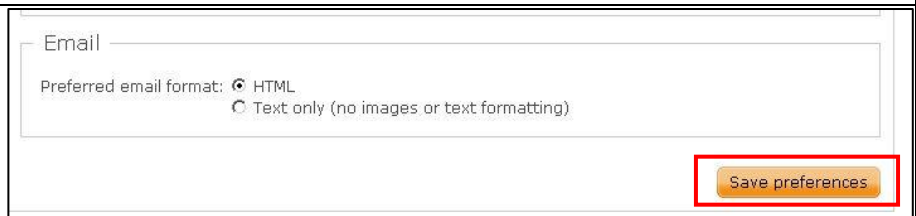
4. On the General interface tab click the drop list for **Language**. You can **Let your browser choose** if you want ProQuest Dialog to detect where you are accessing the internet and change the language accordingly, or you can click on the language of your choice, for example, **Français**.



You have chosen Français and when you save the change it will be set as your default.



5. Scroll down and click **Save preferences**.



Voilà! You have changed the interface language to *Français*.



6. Now you're ready to begin choosing databases and searching.

Note: Although the interface's language has changed, the name of the database and the content of the records remain in the original language – something to keep in mind when entering search terms and retrieving records.

However, ProQuest Dialog provides a **translate** feature in the record displays.

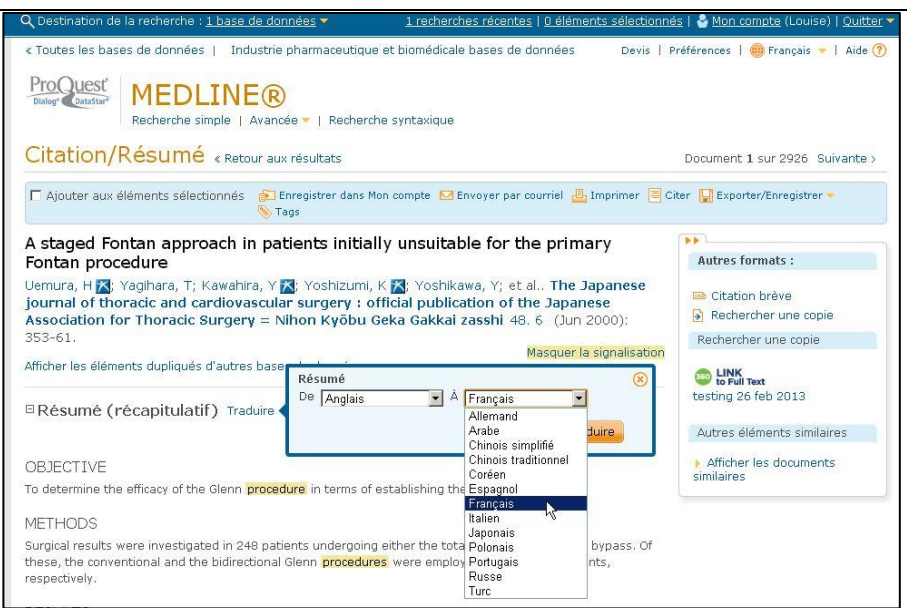


7. The Results page displays in French; the records are in their original languages.



8. In individual displayed records click **Traduire (Translate)** and choose the languages from which and to which to translate.

Note: This translation feature is built in to the interface and is designed to be an "on-the-fly" machine translation of selected content from our databases. This functionality is provided solely for your convenience at no additional charge and is in no way intended to replace human translation.
