

SAVING & EXPORTING RESULTS

Export results to EndNote, Reference Manager or ProCite

TASK: Export your research to citation-management software, such as EndNote®, Reference Manager® or ProCite®. In this example you will export records to EndNote using Download all results.

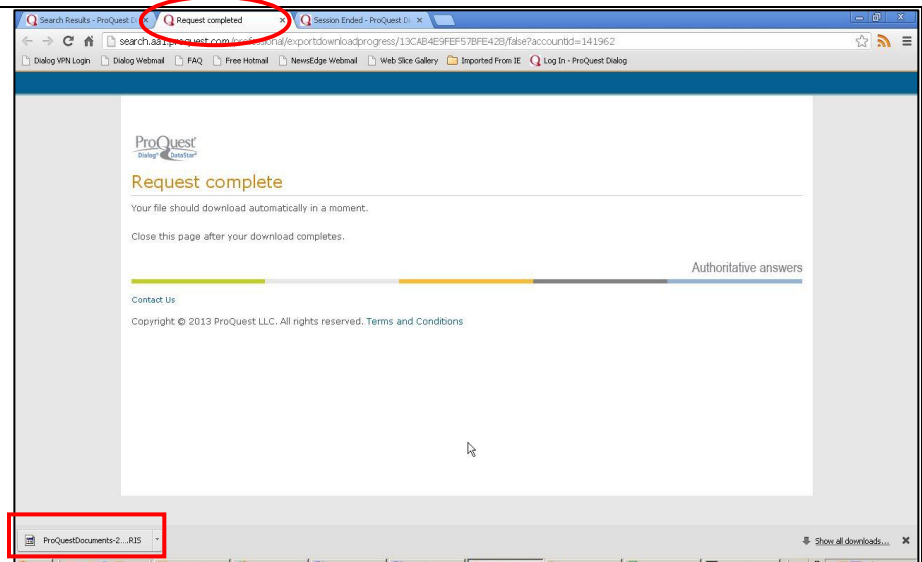
<p>1. After running a search you can choose to Download all results and link to EndNote, Reference Manager or ProCite.</p>	
<p>2. Alternatively, browse titles, preview records and select records to export to EndNote. Click Export/Save and link to EndNote, Reference Manager, or ProCite.</p>	
<p>2. Choose the format you wish, from Results listing only to Citation/Abstracts (full indexing, abstract) and click Continue.</p>	

3. A new browser tab or Web page opens as your documents download in citation-management-ready format – RIS.

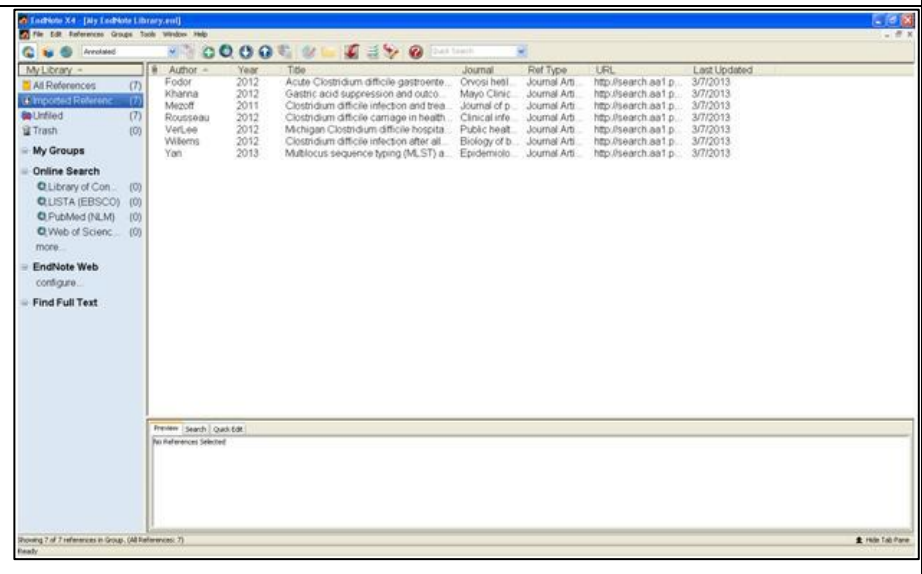
Find, click, open and save to your hard drive the feed on the download icon at the bottom of the page.

When finished, close this page.

Note: some browsers may present a pop-up dialog box with the option to open the .RIS documents.



4. Your records appear in EndNote and you are ready to work with them.
